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Image in surgery, surgery in images

Surgery, as all the medical science, is not possible to be learned theoretically only. While studying, contact with “a master” is desirable and necessary issue. Modern communication and image storage technologies play essential role in surgery teaching. Both, illustrated works of fathers of medicine and voice and image storage in the Internet era, including 3D technology, have exactly the same goal: to show “how that should be done” or “how I do that”.
